Location Knowledge		The United Kingdom (UK) - The four different countries. Vocabulary: England, Scotland, Ireland, Wales and United Kingdom (UK).
Human and Physical Geography	 Seasons/Weather: Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom. Vocabulary: Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter, sun, wind, cloud, rain, snow, ice, storm, lightning, showers, fog, hail, sleet and gail. Hot and cold places: Identify the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles. Vocabulary: Hot, cold, North Pole, South Pole, Equator and country names. Features of an island: Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to the features of an island. Physical Vocabulary: beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather. Human Vocabulary: city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop. 	
Geographical skills and fieldwork	A local study of the village of Whitegate: Use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment. Vocabulary: Whitegate, village, school, farming, field, church, graveyard, road, homes, neighbourhood, green spaces, forest and river.	Compass Points and directional language: Use simple compass directions and locational and directional language to describe the location of features and routes on a map. Vocabulary: North, East, South, West, near, far, left and right.
