Finance

With the reformation of the PTA, the Barclays bank account held by FOWS is being closed, the sum of £22897.84, raised for the school, moved into the school budget. Before the account is finally closed, there will be a final check for any subscriptions, e.g. "parent kind", and insurance. - ClassList is free of charge.

Recent funds raised at the Disco £846 (after expenses), and the sleepover £1118 + additions funds to come, were paid straight into the school account.

A new NatWest bank account is being set up - ACTION: Claire There will be additional signatories (non-school employees) added to the account: Ben and Becky

Additional Event discussion:

Summer fair and Maypole - Mrs. M provided a brief explanation of the history of the summer fair and the relationship between the school, church and community. There has been issues in the past, however Mrs. M has had conversations with John Delaney, chair of the church committee regarding the school and church coming together again to host a community event.

Currently the church holds Bands and BBQ (28th June 2025), raising money through ticket, food and drinks. Suggestion that the school could join in with this event selling (and keeping the proceeds) for the tickets sold through school. Question raised: What do people get for their money?

Maypole. Currently the maypole is being fixed.

There were a number of options discussed about how the school could be a part of the established event. 1. Use the stage on the green to dance (no maypole on the green due to the staging of the Bands) 2. Do the maypole on the green as a separate event. 3. Maypole on the playground, creating a larger event.

It was agreed that with continued conversation with the church committee, it would be good to bring the community together again and coincide the events. ACTION: Mrs M. To further conversions. This would mean doing the maypole on the playground, and the school providing additional stalls and activities. Old fashioned summer fairs, coconut shy, penalty shoot-out. Mr Fowles, to get football fame in.

Maypole wouldn't be charged.

Raffle/Silent auction: ideas such as laundry, visit to the mines, car service, TV. It would be good to see what connections we have through parents.
