<b>Location Knowledge</b>		<b>The United Kingdom (UK) - The four different countries.</b> <b>Vocabulary:</b> England, Scotland, Ireland, Wales and United Kingdom (UK).
<b>Human and Physical Geography</b>	<p><b>Seasons/Weather:</b>            Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom.  <b>Vocabulary:</b> Spring, Summer, Autumn, Winter, sun, wind, cloud, rain, snow, ice, storm, lightning, showers, fog, hail, sleet and gail.</p> <p><b>Hot and cold places:</b>            Identify the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.  <b>Vocabulary:</b> Hot, cold, North Pole, South Pole, Equator and country names.</p> <p><b>Features of an island:</b>            Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to the features of an island.  <b>Physical Vocabulary:</b> beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather.  <b>Human Vocabulary:</b> city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop.</p>	
<b>Geographical skills and fieldwork</b>	<p><b>A local study of the village of Whitegate:</b>            Use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.  <b>Vocabulary:</b> Whitegate, village, school, farming, field, church, graveyard, road, homes, neighbourhood, green spaces, forest and river.</p>	<p><b>Compass Points and directional language:</b>            Use simple compass directions and locational and directional language to describe the location of features and routes on a map.  <b>Vocabulary:</b> North, East, South, West, near, far, left and right.</p>
